ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TERMS

- 01) ONLY AUTHORIZED DRIVERS are allowed to move or drive the motor home.. Authorized drivers are listed on the Motor home Rental Contract and are subject to the approval of Saunders RV Rentals, Inc.
- 02) SIDE DEAD BOLT locks are to be set in the locked position at all times while the vehicle is in motion.
- 03) NO ONE is allowed to TAKE OR EAT ANY FOOD in the UPPER BUNK AREA. This is necessary for us to maintain sanitary conditions at all times in the upper bunk area.
- 04) AT NO TIME is ANYONE to climb the ladder or go on the roof for any reason whatsoever.
- 05) MOTORHOME IS TO BE RETURNED FULL OF PROPANE or a \$15.00 filling fee will be charged in addition to the cost of the propane.
- 06) VEHICLE IS TO BE RETURNED FULL OF FUEL or there will be a \$15.00 fueling charge in addition to the cost of the fuel. Only UNLEADED MIDGRADE fuel is to be added to the fuel tank.
- 07) WASTE WATER HOLDING TANKS (GREY WATER AND SEWER WATER) ARE TO BE EMPTY upon return of the motor home. There will be a \$30.00 charge to empty and rinse the holding tanks that are not empty.
- 08) GENERATOR will not run if the main fuel tank is below ¼ on the gauge.
- 09) THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS in coach # ___ is limited to ___, the number of seatbelts in the coach.
- 10) If the motor home is involved in an accident and/or if the motor home is damaged in any way, the first order of business will be to determine whether anyone has been injured and to summon emergency help to administer medical treatment as necessary. Next the Police should be called to survey the circumstances of the accident and to secure the scene, if that is necessary. Lastly, call Saunders RV Rentals (SRVR) ASAP to report the incident (please refer to the list of phone numbers in the three ring binder sent with you in the motor home). If the police are at the scene, a Police Report will undoubtedly be forthcoming and it is important to get the following information, the NAME of the OFFICER in charge, a REPORT NUMBER applicable to the investigation underway and a PHONE NUMBER and ADDRESS at which a copy of the Police Report can be obtained. If a police report is being prepared and the necessary information has been recorded to get a copy of the completed police report it will not be necessary to complete any further accident report(s).

Any other Damage, not involving another person's vehicle or property (police not summoned) must be reported using the "Accident Report" form found in the three ring binder. Fill out all information applicable to the situation at hand. At a minimum, complete the "Building damage" section, the "witness" section and on the back side of the Accident Report complete the "Factors contributing to accident"/ "describe what happened" sections. Please have the person(s) who completed the report, be sure to sign and date on the customer signature line Please refer to the samples of the "Accident report", the "Automobile Loss Notice", "Claim Reporting procedures" and "In case of an accident" documents filed in the three ring binder placed in the motor home during your check-out procedure.

- 11) Renter agrees to contact Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. by telephone, at Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. expense, if any repair work to the motor home in excess of \$75.00 is required and obtain Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. authorization for such repair at an authorized agency or repair service. Any such authorization for repair shall not constitute a waiver of any right to charge Renter for such repairs, if, in the opinion of Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. such repairs were required because of the misuse, negligence, or carelessness of Renter or Renter's failure to comply with the terms of this contract or with maintenance instructions given to Renter. Renter shall not permit any lien to be placed on the motor home.
- 12) I have TEST DRIVEN the motor home referenced below, accompanied by a representative of Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. During the TEST DRIVE, I was advised of the following points which I fully understand and agree to operate the motor home as instructed and in consideration of each point.
- a) The motor home requires a minimum of 12 feet of clear space through which the coach can pass without damaging the upper area of the coach.
 - b) The coach body behind the cab in 15" wider on each side of the coach than the width of the cab. When meeting ON COMING TRAFFIC and/or when passing a parked vehicle or parking, it is imperative that you allow for added width on the appropriate side(s) of the vehicle.
 - c) Approximately 12 feet of coach body extends out over the rear axle. Any TURN negotiated with this coach will cause that part of the coach that extends out beyond the rear axle to SWING OUT in the opposite direction that you are turning. Only a gradual turn executed over 5 to 10 yards will keep the coach from colliding with another object next to the vehicle.
 - d) Turns at intersections must be made so as to avoid any part of the coach from coming in contact with the street curb, light pole, street sign. etc. This can be done by making sure that traffic from either direction is CLEAR and PROCEEDING INTO the intersection with the FRONT of the vehicle BEFORE beginning the turn.
