FOR YOUR SAFETY

The following information is provided to ensure that you are aware of the basic requirements for the safe operation of the motor home rented from Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. Each of the following points will be addressed by your rental representative to verify that you understand the information provided and how to safely operate the motor home rented from Saunders RV Rentals, Inc.

- 01) ALWAYS utilize the factory installed seat belt restraints while the vehicle is in motion.
- 02) Beds, overheads bunks, sofa, dinette or chairs THAT ARE NOT equipped with seat belts or factory restraint systems are NOT SAFE TO OCCUPY while the vehicle is in motion.
- 03) SECURE any loose object PRIOR to placing the coach in motion.
- 04) BE AWARE that the height of the motor home rented from Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. is 12 feet, including roof mounted accessories, and verify clearance of any low object before attempting to pass beneath.
- 05) LOCK all doors while the vehicle is in motion.
- 06) EXHAUST ports for the furnace and hot water heater are extremely hot when in use. Contact with these ports will cause burn injury.
- 07) EMERGENCY window exits are not to be opened except for an emergency. Danger of falling from vehicle exists with the emergency exit open. OBSERVE AND WARN ALL CHILDREN OF THE DANGER.
- 08) SHOWERS and tubs are SLIPPERY WHEN WET and not to be used while the vehicle is in motion. NEVER use either the shower or the tub as a STORAGE area. The added weight bouncing up and down in the shower or tub while the vehicle is in motion will cause costly damage, which must be avoided.
- 09) OPEN stairwells and other objects are potential hazards during darkness. Be aware of their location and use maximum lighting available to avoid a possible injury.
- 10) AWNING operation can cause finger and hand injury if not performed properly. KNOW the operation of the awning before attempting to use the awning. TRAINING on the proper operation of the awning will be conducted and fully documented at check-out.
- 11) DISCONTINUE operation of the motorhome during HIGH WIND OR ANY SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS.
- 12) CHILDREN ARE EXPECTED TO BE FULLY SUPERVISED at all times. This is extremely important while the vehicle is in motion. The doors and window locks are not child proof and can be opened at any time. Always store chemicals and dangerous materials OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

- 13) A WALK AROUND of the exterior of the motor home is required ANYTIME the coach engine is started with the purpose of moving the vehicle for ANY REASON.
- A) Start at the passenger front door. Make sure the mirror is in it's extended position and has been cleaned for maximum visibility.
 - B) MAKE SURE THE STEP is retracted and the coach door is secured by the DEADBOLT.
 - C) MAKE SURE all outside compartment doors are secured and those compartments equipped with locks ARE LOCKED.
 - D) Check that all CORDS AND HOSES are disconnected and safely stored away.
 - E) LOOK UNDER the coach (both front and rear sections). Make sure there are no objects under the coach or in the path of the TIRES.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE ABOVE SAFETY INFORMATION MAY RESULT IN INJURY OR DEATH. READ ALL MANUFACTURER INFORMATION AND SAFETY TIPS. THESE PAPERS ARE STORED IN THE COACH IN A BINDER WHICH WILL BE LOCATED AND REVIEWED DURING CHECK-OUT. FOLLOW ALL LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL SPEED LAWS. PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND KNOW YOUR VEHICLE'S LIMITATIONS.

I have read all the above information and have been instructed, and understand the proper and safe operation of all appliances and systems contained in this motor home rented from Saunders RV Rentals, Inc. I have been given a copy of these signed procedures for reference during my upcoming trip.
